Delivery of the extended Early Years Education Entitlement (EYEE)

As a provider of the Early Years Education Entitlement (EYEE), you will be aware that all 3 and 4 year olds are currently entitled to a free part time place for up to two years before reaching compulsory school age.

From 2010, the current offer of 12.5 hours will increase to 15 hours per week for 38 weeks of the year and parents will be able to use it more flexibly than at present, over at least 3 days a week.

The first step towards this universal offer is a requirement for Local Authorities to make the entitlement available to 25% of their most disadvantaged 3 and 4 year olds. Local Authorities working with providers must plan for and implement the continued roll out so all eligible children can access a 15 hours place with additional flexibility by 2010.

We would therefore like to invite you as a provider of nursery education to attend one of the briefing sessions that we have planned. At the briefing, you will have the opportunity to:

- Obtain an overview of the national perspective and timelines
- Be introduced to the local delivery plan for 25% implementation for Sept 2009
- Hear about the developing plans for the roll out for the full implementation for September 2010
- Hear how 15 hours and flexibility might be developed based on the experience of a wave 1 pathfinder.
- Ask the questions you may require answering.

The Briefings will be held on 25th and 26th June 2009. They will run at 9.30am, 12.30pm and 3.30pm each day. Each briefing will last an hour and a half, and will be held at the Bentley Hotel, Lincoln.
