

Registering with Environmental Health

Most food businesses are required by law to register with their local council.

Registration tells the Food Safety Officer that the business exists and gives the opportunity for the Officer and business owner to meet and discuss the required standards.

Food Safety Officers also investigate complaints about food premises, monitor local shellfish industry and test food and water samples.

Most Childcare providers handle and prepare food at some point during the day and are required under health and safety laws to register with Environmental Health. Once registered a food safety officer will come and visit the premises from between once a year to once every 4 years depending on what foods you prepare.

The food safety officer may advise that you use the Safer Food Better Business toolkit. Safer Food Better Business (SFBB) is an innovative and practical approach to food safety management. It has been developed to help small businesses put in place food safety management procedures and comply with food hygiene regulations.
