As you can see in the autumn term, terms 1 and 2 and the spring term, terms 3 and 4 you are overpaid days in relation to the actual local authority delivery weeks and in the summer term, terms 5 and 6 you receive payment for 2 days less than the actual delivery weeks. However you are paid for the bank holiday during the spring term. Overall the local authority term dates and the EYE delivery dates balance out in your favour.

The Birth to Five Service also recognises that additional inset days set by schools or localised arrangements may mean slightly fewer days are delivered. We accept this as part of the working practicalities in delivering the EYE.

During the academic year 2011-2012 we would expect you to follow the above dates, ensuring where possible that your dates align with the local maintained provision. We would not expect to see commissioned providers closing a full week before the local authority term end.
