Continuous Provision:

Definition:

Carefully chosen and organised quality resources placed in areas which are always available for children to access independently across every area of learning.



Why Continuous Provision?

- Takes account of children's predictable interests
- Provides security and continuity for children's learning
- Provides opportunities for all areas of the curriculum to be accessed
- Enables children to develop concentration and perseverance
- Promotes independence
- Enables children to consolidate and develop skills and concepts
- Supports the EYFS Themes, Principles and Commitments

Enhanced provision are resources that are added to Continuous Provision within the indoor and outdoor learning environment which match the topic or the interests of children.....



Why Enhanced Provision?

- Links to the theme or topic
- Links to the interests of the children
- Adds interest to the Continuous Provision
